




The REH



Réseau Environnement Humanitaire (Humanitarian Environment Network)

Since 2012, restructured in 2021

Francophone humanitarians & development workers to reduce environmental footprint of aid

300+ members

30+ orgs

4 working groups to operationalise : waste, carbon, sustainable procurement and environmental assessments

The Carbon WG





Since 2021

- Grew out of a consortium of organisations aiming to assess their Carbon Footprint
- Collaboration with other groups and network (HCC development, WREC scope3, ...)

Since 2023: welcomed new organisations and widened the purpose of the WG

Since 2024: revised the WG governance to adopt new objectives

- Provide peer-to-peer assistance on technical topics linked to decarbonization
- Produce tools and analysis to help the decarbonization of aid organisations in general
- Support WG members decarbonization trajectories
- Build WG members knowledge on carbon related topics







What we did in 2024



Initiatives were identified to be the focus of the working group

- Action guides: building and sharing best practices and practical tips on specific decarbonizing actions
- **Specialized Workshop**: developing a workshop tailored for the Aid sector to help raise awareness and build action plans in our countries of operation
- **Carbon footprint**: calculation and monitoring

The WG meetings enabled members to **share their internal progress and strategies** regarding these topics. They also provided opportunities to **hear from external actors**.

A new governance was drafted and adopted to:

- Make the working group more dynamic, and focus on formalizing and sharing our work
- Re-examine our purpose and our priorities for 2025 and beyond






















Ex: Tailored Workshop for the Aid sector


Goal:

- Develop a tool that can include field activities emissions
- That goes beyond awareness-raising to focus on action, and engages field staff
- Ensure that the tool can be widely used (supporting materials for facilitation)

Results:

- First version developed and tested with success under the right condition
- More work needed to make workshop customization easier & to develop facilitation aids











Our objectives in 2025



1. Sharing our learnings with the wider community:

- o Summarize and publish guidances based on what our organizations have learned and the collective decisions we took (the basics at the start of an organization's carbon journey)
- o Build a Carbon Toolkit: with our key findings and advice, and enriched with technical recommendations

2. Work on our reduction trajectories and targets

Ex: Carbon toolkit


Context:

- A complex topic, about which Humanitarian organizations don't have pre-existing knowledge
- A large number of information and tools, mostly aimed at private companies

Goal:

- A clear methodological framework to guide organisations on their carbon accounting journey
- Lessons learned from the NGOs engaged in the process since 2020 in this WG
- Tools and guidances developed by members of the WG

Challenges ahead



- Impact of institutional aid cuts
- Funding needs to finance NGO transition and initiatives (i.e. carbon toolkit)
- HR needs: impact of US aid cuts on dedicated staffs
- Carbon footprint calculation challenges: uncertainties, data quality, lack of specific emission factors
- Resistance to change
- Choice and prioritization of carbon reduction measures
- Availability and cost of low-carbon goods and equipment
